ORDINANCE NO. 2007-03

CONSERVATION FUTURES
FUNDING SHIFT AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, in December of 2005 the Board of Ferry County adopted Ordinance 2005-08 issuing Ballot Measure #1 Allowing a One-Time Reallocation of Conservation Future Funds; and

WHEREAS, in February 2006 the voters of Ferry County passed this measure to authorized the legislative authority to make a one time emergency reallocation of unspent conservation futures funds to pay for other government purposes; and

WHEREAS, Section 1.2 of Ordinance 2005-08 states that a "fiscal funding emergency wherein county revenue projected for 2006 will be insufficient to meet current expense necessary to fund essential county governmental services and no other funding sources currently exist to meet the short fall in current expense funds." and


WHEREAS, due to a change in the financial status, it was deemed unnecessary to utilize these funds during FY 2006; and


WHEREAS, as future financial stability is uncertain, it may be necessary to utilize Conservation Futures in subsequent years.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Board of Ferry County Commissioners hereby authorizes the shift of Conservation Futures for the use of other essential government operations in any year subsequent to 2006 if and when deemed necessary.






