

FERRY COUNTY
ORDINANCE NO. 2010-06
RESTRICTING RANGE AREAS TO CATTLE ONLY

WHEREAS, livestock other than cattle running at large in range areas have caused significant problems in Ferry County, including automobile accidents, crop damage and over-grazing; and


WHEREAS, until 1989 the Legislature had not sufficiently defined "livestock" to enable county government to determine which species were included; and

WHEREAS, by Chapter 286, Section 4 of the Regular Session Laws of 1989, the Legislature amended RCW 16.24.010 to identify cattle, horses, mules, and donkeys as those species permitted to run at large in range areas; and

WHEREAS, in Chapter 286, Section 4 of the Regular Session Laws of 1989 the Legislature provided that the County Legislative Authority could designate areas where it shall be unlawful to permit any livestock other than cattle to run at large.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Ferry County Board of Commissioners that in those areas of Ferry County that are presently range areas, that is, that are not designated as stock restricted area, it shall be unlawful to permit any livestock other than cattle to run at large.
