

**FERRY COUNTY ORDINANCE  
NO. 2012-02**

Whereas, the Board finds RCW 70.93.097 requires counties to adopt an ordinance to reduce litter from vehicles by requiring loads being transported to a staffed transfer station or landfill to secure or cover the vehicle's waste in a manner that will prevent spillage.

**Unsecured loads – Additional charge**

All loads arriving at Torboy Transfer Station shall be covered or secured so as to prevent any solid waste being transported from unintentionally falling or blowing out of the vehicle.

Section I. After JUNE 7, 2012, any vehicle arriving at the Torboy Transfer Station which contains waste that is not covered or secured shall be charge an additional charged an additional fee as follows:

A: for vehicles with gross vehicle weights up to and including 8,000 pounds, the additional charge shall be \$10.00.

B: for vehicles with gross vehicle weights over 8,000 pounds, the additional charge shall be \$20.00.

C: Transfer station operator based upon his/her experience may provide exemptions for vehicle operators transporting waste that is unlikely to spill from a vehicle.


Section II. All monies collected under this section shall be placed in unsecured loads additional charge account.

Section III. The unsecured loads additional charge account shall be disbursed no less often than quarterly, and shall be used by the solid waste management division only for the purposes of reducing and remediating littering and illegal dumping.




