

FERRY COUNTY
ORDINANCE No. 2013-02
(Amending Ordinance No. 2007-01)
AMENDING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS
ON COUNTY ROADS WITHIN FERRY COUNTY

WHEREAS, RCW 36.32.120 provides that "the legislative authorities of several counties shall: (2) Lay out, discontinue, or alter county roads and highways within their respective counties, and do all other necessary acts relating thereto according to law, except within cities and towns which have jurisdiction over the roads within their limits...", and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.75.040 provides that " The board of county commissioners of each county, in relation to roads and bridges, shall have the power and it shall be its duty to...(4) Perform all acts necessary and proper for the administration of the county roads of such county as by law provided", and


WHEREAS, RCW 46.61.415 authorizes local authorities to establish maximum speed limits on roads within their jurisdiction based on engineering and traffic investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Ferry County Public Works Department has conducted engineering studies and observations on Fish Hatchery Road No. 2840 in Ferry county; and


WHEREAS, the Ferry County Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on February 19th, 2013 @ 2:30 PM to hear public testimony regarding the amendment of maximum speed limit on Fish Hatchery Road No. 2840.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Ferry County Board of Commissioners, after due deliberation and in the best interest of the public, does hereby amend the maximum speed limits on Fish Hatchery Road No. 2840 as published in Appendix "A" of Ordinance No. 2007-01 to twenty-five (25) mph. This ordinance designates maximum speeds only. Geometric and weather conditions may require motorists to drive at even slower speeds on county roads.




