Rededication ourselves to improve safety and health in every American workplace.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Ferry County Commissioners do hereby proclaim April 28, 2016 as:

"WORKERS MEMORIAL DAY"


In recognition of workers killed, injured or disabled on the job.
