WHEREAS, The Revised Code of Washington State, Chapter 39.34 authorizes local governments to enter into agreements to make efficient use of their powers on a basis of mutual advantage to provide services to communities; and


WHEREAS, the Ferry County Public Works Department is required by RCW 17.10.140 to control noxious weeds growing on their property; and


WHEREAS, the Ferry County Noxious Weed Control Board has personnel and equipment deemed necessary for the administration of the County's noxious weed control program.





RESOLUTION NO. 06-03

A Resolution Waiving Use Fees for Radio Communication Site

WHEREAS, Public Utility District No. 1 of Ferry County has maintained, and continues to maintain, a security building located on Klondike Mountain for the purpose of housing the Utility's radio communication equipment, and

WHEREAS, the Utility has made excess building space available to other area radio users, i.e. Governmental and private industries, at a very reasonable cost, and

WHEREAS, two of these entities have been the Ferry County Sheriff's Department and the Ferry County Public Works Department, and

WHEREAS, P.U.D. No. 1 of Ferry County will locate a new radio antenna and related radio communication equipment on Franson Peak to better establish communication in the northern portion of the District, and


WHEREAS, the new antenna and equipment will be located upon property now in the name of Ferry County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Utility will cease billing both Ferry County entities for their continued use of the radio building located on Klondike Mountain based upon the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement made by and between P.U.D. No. 1 of Ferry County and the Ferry County Commissioners that Ferry County will not at any time assess a fee upon the Utility for it's use of the Franson Peak radio site.
