SETTING HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, by Chapter 111, Laws of 1977, provided for the addition of legal holidays by resolution of the local governing legislative authority; and

WHEREAS, the Independence Day Holiday, July 4, declared as a legal holiday, falls on a Tuesday this year, and


WHEREAS, the Ferry County Board of Commissioners is authorized to prescribe the days and hours that county offices shall be kept open for the transaction of business; and

WHEREAS, all non-essential personnel shall not be working, and all those that have to work shall receive double time.




