

FERRY COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2006-17

DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY
FOR THE NORTHEAST WASHINGTON
PILOT DRUG ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Chapter 339, Laws of Washington 2006, Section 104, has created a Northeast Washington Pilot Drug Enforcement Program wherein one Deputy Prosecutor will be hired and designated primarily for drug prosecution in Stevens and Ferry Counties, commencing July 1, 2006;

WHEREAS, the State has authorized \$75,000.00 for wage and benefits. Both Ferry and Stevens County have agreed to pay \$81,351.00 for wage and benefits for the Deputy Prosecutor position;

WHEREAS, the unfunded amount of \$6,351.00 will be paid at a two-thirds (2/3) rate (\$4,229.77) by Stevens County and a one-third (1/3) rate (\$2,114.88) by Ferry County. These figures may be rounded to the nearest dollar;


WHEREAS, the Stevens County Prosecuting Attorney shall be responsible for the salary and benefits, the unfunded salary and benefits as described above and other expenses of the designated Deputy Prosecutor;

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorneys of Ferry County and Stevens County shall appoint a designated Deputy Prosecutor as a Special Deputy Prosecutor pursuant to RCW 36.27.040, as needed to review and prosecute referrals of violations of law under this program as well as other violations of law as needed;






