BUCKHORN MOUNTAIN PROJECT
FINAL SUPPLEMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

LOCAL GOVERNMENT APPROVAL

WHEREAS, as defined in part in RCW 78.56.150 Section (2), requires that an applicant for a large-scale metals mining and milling operation regulated under chapter 82.02 RCW must submit to the relevant county legislative authority an impact analysis describing the economic impact of the proposed mining operation on local government units; and

WHEREAS, Section (2), Subsection (4) states that "The County legislative authority of a county planning under chapter 36.70 RCW may assess impact fees under chapter 82.02 RCW to address economic impacts associated with development of the mining operation. The county legislative authority shall hold at least one public hearing on the economic impact analysis and any proposed mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held at 9:00 a.m. on May 2, 2006 in the Ferry County Commissioners' office at which time public comment was received regarding this analysis; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing all public comment, the Board of Ferry County Commissioners feel that all identified adverse impacts as a result of the Buckhorn Project have had more than adequate mitigation measures in place.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Ferry County Commissioners hereby approves the Buckhorn Mountain Project Final Supplemental Environmental Impact statement as presented.


