DECLARING SURPLUS VEHICLE

TO THE HUSKY CAR & TRUCK MUSEUM

WHEREAS, RCW 36.34.020(1) provides that whenever the county legislative authority desires to dispose of any county property it must publish a notice of intention to sell except (1) "When selling to a governmental agency"; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.34.02(3) exempts the notice of intent to sell "When the value of the property to be sold is less than two thousand five hundred (\$2,500.00);

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Ferry County Sheriff's Office that the following vehicle identified hereafter is no longer of use to Ferry County Search and Rescue and is worth less than two thousand five hundred (\$2,500.00);


World War II Vintage Military Ambulance REO Truck




