LIMITING THE USE OF OPEN FLAME

WHEREAS, recent climatic conditions, including high temperatures, wind and lack of precipitation have caused extremely dry conditions throughout Ferry County; and

WHEREAS, during the summer of 2007, the Board of Ferry County Commissioners is taking a proactive approach to prevent man made wildfires within its boundaries by limiting the use of open flames; and


WHEREAS, the use of open flames in areas other than designated campgrounds at the present time creates a risk of wildfires that could result in imminent danger to citizens and/or property.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that effective July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2007 all open flames are prohibited in the unincorporated areas of Ferry County. This order is not intended to preclude the use of backyard barbecues, chimneys or other patio/deck warmers as long as only approved fuel is used; seasoned (clean and dry) firewood, briquettes or propane. Approved campfires at designated places in parks and campgrounds are also allowed as determined by agencies with jurisdiction. Disposal of vegetative waste in a recreational fire is prohibited. This restriction is in effect immediately and until further notice.


Any violation of this declaration shall be punishable by a minimum of 90 days imprisonment and/or a \$1,000 fine.



# FERRY COUNTY BURN BAN IN EFFECT

IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES THE BOARD OF FERRY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HAS ISSUED A BURN BAN THROUGHOUT FERRY COUNTY.

EFFECTIVE JULY 16, 2007, AND UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING IS PROHIBITED EXCEPT FOR DESIGNATED FIRE PITS IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC CAMPGROUNDS OUTSIDE THE INCORPORATED AREA OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC.

THIS ORDER IS NOT INTENDED TO PRECLUDE THE USE OF BACKYARD BARBECUES, CHIMNEYS OR OTHER PATIO/DECK WARMERS AS LONG AS ONLY APPROVED FUEL IS USED; SEASONED FIREWOOD, BRIQUETTES OR PROPANE. APPROVED CAMPFIRES AT DESIGNATED PLACES IN PARKS AND CAMPGROUNDS ARE ALSO ALLOWED AS DETERMINED BY AGENCIES WITH JURISDICTION.

THE BOARD ENCOURAGES THE PUBLIC TO USE EXTREME CAUTION WHEN USING ANY OPEN FLAME.

(ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A MINIMUM OF 90 DAYS IMPRISONMENT AND/OR \$1,000.00 FINE.)

RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS COUNTY PROPERTY

WHEREAS, RCW 36.34.020(3) provides that if "property to be sold is worth less than two thousand five hundred dollars", it can be sold without compliance with the publication, public hearing and auction provisions of RCW Chapter 36.34; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.34.050 provides that "The County legislative authority may set a minimum sale price on property that is proposed for sale"; and

that it wishes to surplus; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Ferry County Commissioners has determined that they have minimal monetary value; and
