Rates set for calendar year: 2008

**Labors and General:**

CURRENT MINIMUM WAGE

Qualifications include; 18 years of age, have a Washington driver's license, and have a positive attitude toward the public. Must have reliable transportation and be able to work up to 60 hours per week.

**Flaggers:**

Step 1: 9.76  
Step 2: 11.19

Same as labors, plus ability to operate pilot car, have and maintain a current flagging card and have a neat appearance. Step increases will be considered on written recommendation of supervisor and completion of required hours of service; Step 1: less than 173 hours; Step 2: over 173 hours.

**Equipment Operators:**

10.42

Must have basic equipment operating skills, no Commercial Drivers license required.

**Equipment Operators with CDL Class A endorsement:**

16.71

Ability to operate and maintain heavy equipment and must have a Commercial Drivers license with Class A endorsement.


**Engineering Technician:**


Step 1: 10.75  
Step 2: 11.75

Applicable education may be required depending upon the job requirements. Step increases will be considered on written recommendation of supervisor and completion of required hours of service; Step 1: less than 173 hours; Step 2: over 173 hours. A current Flagging and Traffic Control card is required.




