Rates set for calendar year: **2009**

Labors and General:

CURRENT MINIMUM WAGE

Qualifications include; 18 years of age, have a Washington driver's license, and have a positive attitude toward the public. Must have reliable transportation and be able to work up to 60 hours per week.

Flaggers:

Step 1:	10.24
Step 2:	11.67

Same as labors, plus ability to operate pilot car, have and maintain a current flagging card and have a neat appearance. Step increases will be considered on written recommendation of supervisor and completion of required hours of service; Step 1: less than 173 hours; Step 2: over 173 hours.

Equipment Operators:

10.90

Must have basic equipment operating skills, no Commercial Drivers license required.

Equipment Operators with CDL Class A endorsement:

17.19


Ability to operate and maintain heavy equipment and must have a Commercial Drivers License with Class A endorsement.

Engineering Technician:

Step 1:	11.23
Step 2:	12.23

Applicable education may be required depending upon the job requirements. Step increases will be considered on written recommendation of supervisor and completion of required hours of service; Step 1: less than 173 hours; Step 2: over 173 hours. A current Flagging and Traffic Control card is required.
