

FERRY COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2009-44

FOR THE PURPOSE OF PUTTING THE RAIL CORRIDOR USE ON THE
BALLOT FOR A COUNTY WIDE ADVISORY VOTE

WHEREAS, on December of 2008 a portion of Kettle Falls International Railway, LLC, San Poil Subdivision from milepost 48.779, near Danville, and milepost 77.14 at San Poil, a distance of 28.361 miles, in Ferry County, Washington was rail banked; and

WHEREAS, the Ferry County Board of Commissioners appointed a Recreational Trails Committee to draft a Management/Maintenance Plan for the Rail Corridor; and


WHEREAS, the subject of the use of the Rail Corridor has been a concern to the adjacent land owners and other Ferry County residents. The Recreational Trails Committee has advised/requested that the Board of County Commissioners place the use of the Rail Corridor on the November Ballot for a County wide advisory vote, and

WHEREAS, the Ferry County Board of Commissioners, by resolution have made the decision to place the Rail Corridor use on the November Ballot for a County wide advisory vote.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners the following:

- The Rail Corridor use will be put on the November Ballot for an advisory vote.
- The Ferry County Auditor shall conduct the election in accordance with general election law and the election shall be canvassed by the County Canvassing Board.
- The election shall be County wide by qualified electors within the boundaries of Ferry County.
- The Ferry County Prosecuting Attorney is hereby requested to write an appropriate ballot title to place on the November Ballot to assist the Board of County Commissioners in determining the use of the Rail Corridor.
