

**FERRY COUNTY
RESOLUTION NO. 2010-30
DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY
DUE TO EXTREME WEATHER AND FIRES**

WHEREAS, recent weather conditions, including high temperatures, high winds and lack of precipitation have caused extremely dry conditions in Ferry County; and

WHEREAS, said weather conditions have caused wildfires in Ferry County; and


WHEREAS, at the Emergency Meeting held August 27, 2010 the Ferry County Board of Commissioners has determined that as of 1:17 PM on August 26, 2010 emergency conditions exist in Ferry County as defined in RCW 36.40.180; and

WHEREAS, local county resources are inadequate to fund the emergency work necessary to minimize damages to the county, and state and federal assistance is required pursuant to RCW 38.52.070(2) and other state and federal laws pertaining to disaster emergencies and assistance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a disaster emergency exists, and has existed since August 26, 2010 within Ferry County resulting in imminent danger to citizens and property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Ferry County Board of Commissioners hereby request that the Governor of the State of Washington, together with other appropriate State and Federal officials, make such emergency declarations and provide such assistance within Ferry County pursuant to 42U.S.C.5191-5193 as required and allowed by law.
