RESOLUTION NO. 2011-26
DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY
DUE TO EXTREME FLOODING AND
DAMAGE TO COUNTY ROADS

WHEREAS, recent weather conditions, including warm weather and heavy rain fall has caused rapid melting of snow from the surrounding mountain tops; and

WHEREAS, said weather conditions have caused extreme flooding and extensive damage to County roads; and

WHEREAS, at the Emergency Meeting held May 26, 2011 in the Sheriff's Office the Ferry County Board of Commissioners has determined that as of 11:30 am May 26, 2011 emergency conditions exist in Ferry County as defined in RCW 36.40.180; and


WHEREAS, local county resources are inadequate to fund the emergency work necessary to minimize damages to the county, and State and Federal assistance is required pursuant to RCW 36.52 and other state and federal laws pertaining to disaster emergencies and assistance.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a disaster emergency exists, and has existed since May 26, 2011 within Ferry County resulting in imminent danger to the health, safety and welfare of citizens, property and county roads.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Ferry County Board of Commissioner hereby request that the Governor of the State of Washington, together with other State and Federal officials, make such emergency declarations and provide such assistance within Ferry County as required and allowed by law.


