COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO. 2014-14

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FERRY COUNTY,  
WASHINGTON:

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) are seeking to extend control over additional "Waters of the United States"; and

WHEREAS, the agencies have expanded their authority under the Clean Water Act to implement an onerous permit system that has forced delays as well as caused unnecessary additional expense to projects on the local level; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Supreme Court previously reprimanded the agencies for over-reaching their authority and Congress has recently documented concern with the effort to re-define the scope of federal power under the Clean Water Act;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Ferry County Board of County Commissioners opposes additional regulations that have been proposed by EPA to re-define the current definition as well as implement additional enforcement with respect to the Clean Water Act and the Waters of the United States.






