**LIMITING THE USE OF OPEN FLAME**

**WHEREAS**, recent climatic conditions, including high temperatures, wind and lack of precipitation have caused extremely dry conditions throughout Ferry County; and


**WHEREAS**, in recent weeks, areas in and surrounding Ferry County have been victim to large wildfires, the Board of Ferry County Commissioners is taking a proactive approach to prevent man made wildfires within its boundaries by limiting the use of open flames; and

**WHEREAS**, the use of open flames at the present time creates a risk of wildfires that could result in imminent danger to citizens and/or property.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that effective immediately all open flames are prohibited in the Ferry County. This order is not intended to preclude the use of backyard barbecues. Disposal of vegetative waste in a recreational fire is prohibited. This restriction is in effect immediately and until further notice.

**Any violation of this declaration shall be punishable by a minimum of 90 days imprisonment and/or a \$1,000 fine.**


