Resolution Declaring State of Emergency in regards to Wolf Predation in Ferry County

WHEREAS, the Ferry County Board of Commissioners have received confirmation from the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife that there are wolf packs in Ferry County, and

WHEREAS, there have been confirmed wolf kills in Ferry County on domestic animals, and

WHEREAS, this Wolf activity poses a threat to the health, safety and welfare of children, citizens, property, pets and livestock, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife has recently deviated from the Washington State Wolf Management Plan in regards to Wolf Pack removal in Northeast Washington.


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Ferry County Board of Commissioners declare a State of Emergency for the protection of our citizens.


