

**FERRY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
RESOLUTION NO. 2015-34**

ESTABLISHING THE MENTAL HEALTH AND CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY ("MHCD") FUND

AND

**AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF FERRY COUNTY'S 1/10th OF 1% SALES AND USE TAX [EXPANDED
CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY OR MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT SERVICE FUNDS] FROM NEW ALLIANCE IN
STEVEN'S COUNTY TO FERRY COUNTY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 82.14.460, the Board of Ferry County Commissioners on December 27, 2010 authorized and imposed a 1/10th of 1% sales and use tax for the purpose of providing for the operation or delivery of new or expanded chemical dependency or mental health treatment programs and services and for the operation or delivery of new or expanded therapeutic court programs and services [Ferry County Commissioners Resolution No. 2010-47]; and

WHEREAS the funds generated from the 1/10th of 1% sales and use tax have, to date, been transferred to New Alliance (located in Stevens County, Washington) for the purpose of providing chemical dependency and mental health treatment to qualifying citizens of Ferry County; and

WHEREAS a portion of the funds that were transferred to New Alliance have not been used; and

WHEREAS the Mental Health/Chemical Dependency Treatment Sales Tax Oversight Committee (STOC) now desires the unused funds to be returned to Ferry County to be used for the benefit of Ferry County citizens, including for the establishment of a Ferry County Adult Therapeutic/Drug Court Program.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Ferry County, State of Washington as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the creation of a new fund for the purposes of tracking the 1/10th of 1% of sales and use tax. This fund shall be named the MHCD (Mental Health and Chemical Dependency) Fund (fund # 111, dept. # 131).
2. The County hereby authorizes that the totality of the funds generated by the 1/10th of 1% sales and use tax, which is currently being held by New Alliance in Stevens County for the provision of chemical dependency and mental health services, shall be returned to the Ferry County Treasurer via check. The Treasurer is hereby directed to receipt these funds into the new MHCD Fund (fund # 111, dept. # 131).
3. Any and all future funds generated by the 1/10th of 1% sales and use tax for the provision of chemical dependency and mental health services shall likewise be deposited with the Ferry County Treasurer to be likewise receipted into the MHCD Fund (fund # 111, dept. # 131).


4. All funds generated by the 1/10th of 1% sales and use tax for the provision of chemical dependency and mental health services shall continue to be used in a manner consistent with Ferry County Commissioners Resolution No. 2010-47, including, but not limited to, the establishment of a Ferry County Adult Therapeutic/Drug Court Program.
