**DECLARING WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE'S
FAILURE TO ACT; REASSERTING AN EMERGENCY; DECLARING THE
PROFANITY WOLF PACK A NUISANCE; REMOVING THE PROFANITY
WOLF PACK**

WHEREAS, Ferry County declares a "State of Emergency" effective August 19, 2016; and

WHEREAS, there was no response to the letters sent to James Unsworth at the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife dated July 26, 2016 and August 4, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the profanity wolf pack has become a public nuisance; and

WHEREAS, The Ferry County BOCC has called upon and demand WDFW & Director James Unsworth to remove the Profanity Wolf Pack; and

WHEREAS, the department after 10(14) days has only removed two animals; and

WHEREAS, the department has ceased removal activity; and

WHEREAS, Experts and field staff advise and advocate for full pack removal to stop livestock depredation; and

WHEREAS, Five confirmed depredation, six probable depredations and numerous unconfirmed depredations have previously occurred; and

WHEREAS, depredations on livestock continue, as well as weight loss, dry cows, injuries and other detriments due to being harassed by wolves; and

WHEREAS, Human health and safety is in jeopardy due to unknown wolf movement and activities and livestock carcass, wolf scat on the landscape is often known to contain disease.

- A) Declares the profanity wolf pack a public nuisance;
- B) Declares that the WDFW has failed to act and that Director James Unsworth is derelict in his duty to protect the citizens of Ferry County and the region from human health and safety concerns as well as protect the customs, culture & Economic Stability of Ferry County;
- C) Declares an emergency and authorizes the sheriff to expend the necessary resources to remove the profanity wolf pack in totality;
- D) Calls for the immediate removal of all members of the profanity wolf pack;

This Resolution is necessary for the preservation of peace, safety, human health & preservation of Ferry County's customs, culture & economic stability.




