Road, County Road No. 02240 ) ORDER OF ESTABLISHMENT

In the matter of the establishment the Eagle Track ORV Park Road, the Board finds as follows:

*First.* That Resolution No. 2016-31 Preliminary-Establishment was initiated and accepted by Ferry County on November 21, 2016, and that the Ferry County Engineer was appointed and was duly directed to examine and if necessary survey the route of said proposed road.

*Second.* That on the 20th day of December, 2016 the said appointed Engineer filed in the office of the Board his report in writing, and at the same time his field notes and profiles of the proposed road, and a map, as provided by law, and the 9th day of January, 2017 was set as the day for hearing on said report, and notice of such hearing was duly given by publishing and posting as provided by law.

*Third.* That the Board, having considered said report and all evidence relative to the establishment of the road, and finding that such proposed road is a public necessity.

IT IS ORDERED BY THE BOARD, that the Eagle Track ORV Park Road be established as follows:

That portion of Section 7, Township 36 North, Range 33 E., W.M. described as follows:

A sixty (60) foot wide tract of land for EAGLE TRACK ORV PARK ROAD as shown on exhibit A, a recorded survey by Thomas Carlson, recorded in Ferry County Auditor's Office Auditor Certificate No. 211774, and located over and across the LUNA LODGE, HOME LODGE, IXL FRACTION LODGE, MINERVA FRACTION LODGE and Government Lot 18 all in Section 7, Township 36 North, Range 33 E.W.M.

Said strip of land being 1,478.24 feet or 0.280 miles more or less.

And as shown upon the field notes, profile and map of said Engineer, and that from henceforth said roads shall be County Roads of 60 feet in width exclusive of slopes for cuts and fills, and that the same be opened according to law.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF COUNTY ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY:

To the HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, STATE OF WASHINGTON:

Gentlemen: On the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 2016, pursuant to your Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_, Resolution of Intention and Necessity to Establish a County Road I proceeded to make an examination of the following described portion of proposed county road right-of-way:

That portion of Section 7, Township 36 North, Range 33 E., W.M. described as follows:


A sixty (60) foot wide tract of land for EAGLE TRACK ORV PARK ROAD as shown on exhibit A, a recorded survey by Thomas Carlson, recorded in Ferry County Auditor's Office Auditor Certificate No. 211774, and located over and across the LUNA LODGE, HOME LODGE, IXL FRACTION LODGE, MINERVA FRACTION LODGE and Government Lot 18 all in Section 7, Township 36 North, Range 33 E. W.M.

Said strip of land being 1,478.24 feet or 0.280 miles more or less.

And make the following report in accordance with RCW 36.81.050:

1. As to the necessity of the road.  
*Right of way across various properties has been deeded to Ferry County, see attachments.*
2. As to the proper terminal points, general course and length.  
*In accordance with the attached and recorded survey, Auditor's Certificate No. 211774.:*
3. As to the proper width of right-of-way.  
*Per deeds and survey, 60 feet, 30 feet each side of centerline.*
4. As to the estimated cost of construction, including all necessary bridges, culverts, clearing, grubbing, drainage and grading.  
*Road has been constructed and maintained for several years. No additional cost at this time.*
5. As to whether the proposed roads meets current county road standards per Resolution No. 79-9.  
*Road meets current standards.*
6. Such other facts as may be important for the Board's consideration.  
*Right-of-way has been deeded to Ferry County for several years, some have been recorded some not. The process requires completion.*
