RESOLUTION SETTING TIPPING FEE INCREASE NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, tipping fee cost for disposal of the solid waste collected in Ferry County is in part determined by the Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton Consumer Price Index (CPI).

WHEREAS, the Ferry County Public Works, Solid Waste Division has need to adjust tipping fee periodically to accommodate the CPI increases to maintain a stable financial balance.

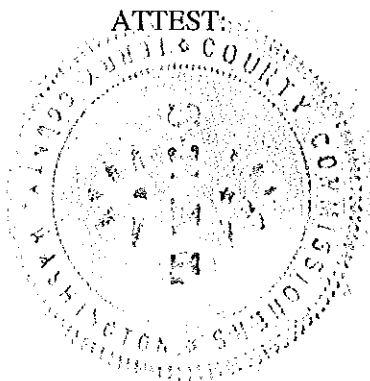
WHEREAS, the CPI adjustment for the following year is typically received in November and effective January 1st.

WHEREAS, Ferry County is required pursuant to RCW 70.95.212 to give a seventy-five day notice of a change in tipping fees at the transfer station to certificated haulers.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Ferry County Public Works, Solid Waste Division to be approved to start the process according to RCW 70.95.212 and to make the needed increase in the tipping fees once the CPI increases \$2.00 or more over the last approved tipping fee increase.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Ferry County, Washington, here by adopts the Tipping Fees Notification and Increase to be aligned with the CPI adjustment. Once the CPI adjustment reaches an increase of \$2.00 or more over the last approved tipping fee increase, Ferry County Public Works, Solid Waste Division will begin the 75 day notification process as per RCW 70.95.212 and raise tipping fees accordingly.


