
**Working Session**

The Commissioners reviewed historical documents regarding the Marcus to Marble Mount Road and discussion was held.


**Unfinished Business**

With no further business the meeting was adjourned at 1:30PM.



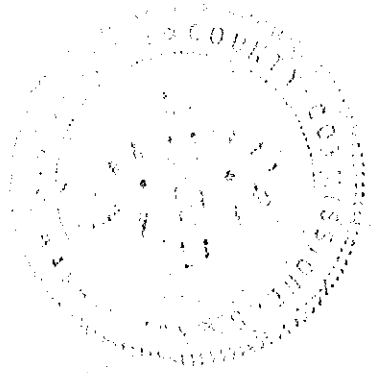
