**Silver Creek Road**

Mr. Reynolds reported that the bank on Silver Creek has been stabilized. The County Road administration funds have been approved to work on Silver Creek Road either next year or the following year when funds become available. Ms. Palmer asked about permits on the Silver Creek repairs; they require a review process before repairs are made. Mr. Reynolds stated that he thought that they had all the permits in place before the work was done. Discussion was held on repairs still needed on Silver Creek Road. Mr. Reynolds reported that chip sealing and patching will continue to happen on Silver Creek in the next few years. Three miles were done this year, there is a total of 24-25 miles of pavement and it's too pricey to fix all at once. Discussion was held on Bridge Creek repairs. Discussion was held on state funding for roads.

**Intergovernmental Agreement**

Discussion was held on the draft Intergovernmental Agreement with Okanogan County and the Confederated Tribes. The Draft Intergovernmental Agreement with Ferry County closely mirrors the draft Agreement with Okanogan County with a few exceptions. Discussion was held on the permit processes on Fee Lands vs. non-Fee lands. Discussion was held on archeological sites. Ms. Palmer stated that cultural surveys are done to identify archeological sites. Ms. Palmer works with area realtors to educate them on the different regulations on building and developing.

The current and historic boundaries were discussed. Ms. Palmer confirmed that she was referring to the current boundaries and also to include current tribal allotments. Ms. Palmer agreed to send Clerk of the Board Amanda Rowton a draft of the Intergovernmental Agreement. Once the draft is received, Ms. Rowton will forward it to the Prosecutor. Ms. Palmer stated that emails to Mike Nee and Leah VanderStoep at the Planning Department are being bounced back to her still. The Board requested that Ms. Palmer attach any information to Clerk of the Board Amanda Rowton and Ms. Rowton can forward the information to the Commissioners and to the Planning Director.


The Board would like to meet with the Confederated Tribes within the month to discuss the Intergovernmental Agreement after the Prosecutor has reviewed it. Discussion was held on the land use lines/survey lines. Ms. Palmer stated that they should be signing the Intergovernmental Agreement with Okanogan County within the month. Ms. Allen invited the Board to a "meet and greet" with the Inchelium District on Wednesday November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Discussion was held on the All Hazard Mitigation Plan. Ferry County would appreciate a tribal representative on the team. The next All Hazard Mitigation Plan meeting will be October 20<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 p.m. in the Commissioner's Office. The Voluntary Stewardship Program was discussed. Ms. Allen stated that the addressing issue that Ms. Winter worked on has been resolved. Ms. Winter told Ms. Palmer to contact her if there are any more addressing issues. The next meeting between the Confederated Tribes and the Ferry County Commissioners will be held on December 2<sup>nd</sup> at 10:00 a.m. in Nespelem. Discussion was held on riparian zones. Discussion was held on timber salvage.




