

Ferry County Law Library Policy*

In accordance with RCW 27.24.068, the use of the Ferry County Law Library is free to all Washington State Judges, Washington State and County Officials, and members of the Washington State Bar. The Law Library is not open to the general public.

The above-designated individuals may use the Law Library from 1-3 PM on days the Prosecutor's Office is open for business (generally, Monday-Friday, excluding holidays). Law Library hours are subject to revision at the discretion of the Law Library Trustee/Prosecutor.

Unfortunately, the Law Library does not contain any copier or scanning machines.

Permission to remove Law Library materials/items may be given at the discretion of the Law Library/Prosecutor's Staff. Individuals who are given permission to remove or check out Law Library materials/items may be required to provide photo identification, phone number and address, and a \$5 check-out fee which is refundable upon return of Law Library materials/items.

If checked-out materials/items are not returned within two (2) weeks, the \$5 check-out fee will be forfeited and an additional \$5 fee assessed for every week that the materials/items are not returned, up to the value of the non-returned materials/items.

All Visitors to the Ferry County Law Library must also comply with the Ferry County Prosecutor's Office Visitor Policy.
