

Ferry County Prosecutor's Office Visitor Policy

Thank you for visiting the Ferry County Prosecutor's Office. This office often handles sensitive and confidential materials. Please help us ensure the safety of our employees and maintain confidentiality by complying with the following Rules for Visitors:

- All Visitors must use the Public Entrance located on the South side of the building.
- All Visitors must check in at the window inside the Public Entrance. Photo ID may be required and Visitors must disclose the purpose of their visit to Prosecutor's Office Personnel.
- This is a professional office: Visitors must keep noise at a minimum. Visitors who cannot keep noise at a minimum may be asked to wait outside; e.g. Visitors with unruly children or Visitors engaged in loud or disruptive phone conversations.
- Visitors must be respectful and courteous to all Prosecutor's Office Personnel and other Visitors.
- Visitors who engage in abusive, repetitive, aggressive, or harassing behavior will NOT be tolerated and will be asked to leave and/or may be trespassed from the premises.
- Permission to enter the Prosecutor's Office is discretionary on the part of Prosecutor's Office Personnel and may be revoked at any time.
- Visitors to the Prosecutor's Office are NOT permitted to bring, carry, or possess weapons of ANY KIND on the premises.
- Any Visitors wishing to meet with the Prosecutor or Deputy Prosecutor shall schedule an appointment in advance. Please contact the Office Administrator at (509) 775-5225, extension 2506 for more information on how to schedule an appointment.
