

**FERRY COUNTY NOTICE TO CONSULTANTS FOR  
INCHELIUM HIGHWAY REPAIRS**

The FERRY COUNTY solicits interest from consulting firms with expertise in Civil and Structural Engineering Design. This agreement will be for approximately 12 months in duration with the option for the FERRY COUNTY to extend it for additional time and money if necessary. Consultants will be considered for the following project.

Reconstruct failed roadway section. Work consists of development of design and construction plans for the project consisting of culvert replacement, roadway excavation and fill, HMA surfacing, and guardrail as needed. Removal and restoration of bypass detour. Preliminary Engineering, and construction inspection to be completed by consultant. Construction by contractor, oversight by Ferry County Public works.

The FERRY COUNTY reserves the right to amend terms of this “Request for Qualifications” (RFQ) to circulate various addenda, or to withdraw the RFQ at any time, regardless of how much time and effort consultants have spent on their responses.

**Project Description**

The work to be performed by the CONSULTANT consists of preparing preliminary engineering design for improvements to Inchelium Highway Repair, M.P. 19.90 to M.P. 20.10. The proposed improvements include culvert replacement, roadway excavation and fill, HMA surfacing, and guardrail as needed. The major features of the project are as follows:

- Approximately 0.50 miles of damaged road to rebuild.
- Environmental documentation and preparation of permit applications.
- Structural and geotechnical design for culvert replacement.
- Determination of R/W needs and R/W plan preparation
- Development of Contract Plans and Bidding Documents.
- Review of Bidding Documents and Construction Inspection

FERRY COUNTY reserves the right to retain the services of the successful firm(s) for any subsequent phases (R/W, CN) associated with this/these project(s).
