

ORDINANCE NO. 3-70

STOCK RESTRICTED AREA ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE designating an area in Ferry County as a stock restricted area, setting boundaries, providing for penalties and impounding within the meaning of RCW 16.24 and providing for notices.

1. The area included within all of Section 31, S½ of Section 32; SW¼ of the SW¼ and Lot 5 of Section 33; Twp.37N., Range 32 E.W.M.; Lots 1-4 of Section 3; Lots 1-4 of Section 4; Lots 1-4 of Section 5; Lots 1-4 of Section 6; Twp.36N., Range 32E.W.M., is hereby determined to be a stock restricted area wherein it is unlawful for stock to run at large.
2. STOCK AT LARGE IN AREA -UNLAWFUL. No person owning or in control of any stock shall willfully or negligently allow such livestock to run at large in the STOCK RESTRICTED AREA described in paragraph 1, hereof, nor shall any person owning or in control of any livestock allow such livestock to wander or stray upon the right of way of any public highway within the STOCK RESTRICTED AREA described in #1 hereof when not in the charge of some person.
3. It shall be unlawful for any person to cause or permit any livestock to graze or stray upon any portion of the right-of-way of any public highway of the area described in paragraph 1, hereof as a stock restricted area. It shall be unlawful for any person to herd or move any livestock over, along or across the right-of-way of any public highway, or portion thereof, within the above described Stock Restricted Area, without having in attendance a sufficient number of persons to control the movement of such livestock and to warn or otherwise protect vehicles traveling upon such highway from any danger by reason of such livestock being herded or moved thereon.

In the event that any livestock is allowed to stray or graze upon the right-of-way of any public highway, or portion thereof, within the stock restricted area, unattended, the same may be impounded for safekeeping and, if the owner be not known, complaint may be instituted against such stock in a court of competent jurisdiction. Notice shall be published as close as possible to the location where the livestock were found, describing as nearly as possible the stock, where found, and that the same are to be sold. In the event that the owner appears and convinces the court of his right thereto, the stock may be delivered upon payment by him of all costs of court, advertising and caring for the stock. In the event no person claiming the right thereto shall appear by the close of business on the tenth day following and exclusive of the date of publication of notice, the stock may be sold at public or private sale, all costs of court, advertising and caring therefor paid from the proceeds thereof, and the balance certified by the judge of the court ordering such sale, to the treasurer of Ferry County, to be credited to the county school fund.

4. PENALTY. Any person, or any agent, employee or representative of a corporation, violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than two dollars, nor more than ten dollars, for each offense, and it shall be the duty of the prosecuting attorney on complaint of a resident to forthwith enforce the provisions of this section.
5. Notice of the Order adopting this stock restricted area ordinance shall be given by publication in a newspaper having a general circulation in Ferry County once each week for four successive weeks.



ORIENT STOCK RESTRICTED ZONE:

Passed by County Ordinance No. 1-70 on August 20, 1970. Recorded in Commissioners Journal No. 16, pages 70-72.

All that land within the Orient Townsite, bounded by the following:

1. Little Boulder Creek on the North. *MM 263.8 ON 395*
2. Deer Creek on the South. *MM 259 ON 395*
3. Kettle River on the East.
4. Colville National Forest Boundary on the West.

GRANITE CREEK STOCK RESTRICTED ZONE:

(lying approximately 2-6 miles west of Republic)
